

TIMBER JOINT SEALANT

DUNLOP TIMBER JOINT SEALANT is an acrylic sealant for use in joints such as wall and floor joints, for laminate, parquet and wooden floorboards. It has great adhesion and can be sanded and painted over to complete finishing. Suitable for indoor use, this solvent-free formula is the ideal solution for sealing all movement joints up to 30mm. Do not use under waterproofing membranes or in continuous immersion applications.

PRODUCT ATTRIBUTES

Product colours: Beech, Grey Oak

Composition: Paste

Size: 310mL

APPLICATION

Apply at temperatures between 5°C and 35°C.

- 1. Ensure joints and surfaces are dry, clean and free from grease, soap and water.
- Maximum joint width is 30mm and depth 15mm. For joints greater than 10mm deep a backing rod should be used.
 To achieve a neater finish mask joint edges with tape.
- 3. Trim nozzle end to obtain correct bead width and place cartridge in applicator gun.
- Apply sealant in a steady continuous bead ensuring good contact with both sides of the joint. Tool off with DUNLOP Smoothing Tool and moisten with a solution of detergent and water to finish the joint smoothly before a skin forms (10 mins).
- 5. While the sealant is still wet, clean off any excess. If joint edges have been masked, remove tape whilst still wet. If the sealant has dried on the surface, clean with white spirit solvent to soften the sealant then scrape off with a blade.
- 6. Allow 3 days to cure before sanding.

SHELF LIFE

12 months when stored in original unopened packaging in a dry place at 23°C and 50% relative humidity.

PRECAUTIONS

Contact with natural stone, bitumen-based materials and rubber modified adhesives and metals such as brass and copper, may cause discolouration. Not suitable for use in continuous immersion situations.
